IMPORTANT

Do not leave the parade without permission.

02

Do not let anyone who has not applied to the Event Entry Form participate in the parade.

03

Do not wear the costumes that are different from what you have applied to the Event Entry Form.

04

Walk on the sidewalk.

Do not obstruct the passage.

Do not walk while on the phone, distribute flyers, or throw away garbage.

Do not show nuisance behavior towards other participants and citizens.

Do not make any political or religious statements.

Drink a water only when you are not walking.

Do not do anything that will go against the guidance and instructions of the Hokudai-sai Staff.
